The applicant Silver Oak Development Company Limited Partnership, hereby makes application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated.

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Effluent form Carson City Wastewater Treatment Plant
2. The amount of water applied for is 2.23 c.f.s. (not to exceed 500 AFA) second-feet
 - (a) If stored in reservoir give number of acre-feet
3. The water to be used for Irrigation
4. If use is for:

 - (b) Stockwater, state number and kinds of animals to be watered

5. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 15, T.15N., R.20E., M.D.B.&M., at a point from which the W $\frac{1}{4}$ corner of said Section 15 bears N. 34°20'W., a distance of 690 feet
6. Place of Use Refer to Attachment "A"
7. Use will begin about January 1 and end about December 31, of each year.
8. Description of proposed works Effluent pipeline with pump stations "tee" valve & pipeline to place of use.

10. Estimated time required to construct works Two (2) years
11. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use Five (5) years

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This secondary permit is issued subject to the terms and conditions under Permit 30450. The granting of this secondary permit is not intended in any way to waive or affect authority or requirements of appropriate water quality control agencies or regulations. This permit is further issued subject to the provisions of NRS 533.395 and the State retains the right to regulate the use of water herein granted at any and all times. The total combined duty of Permits 30450 S-1, 30450 S-2, 30450 S-3 and 30450 S-4 is limited to 4,822.0 acre-feet annually. The issuance of this permit authorizes the rotational and/or concurrent use of the waste water stored under Permit 30450 between the four places of use described under Permits 30450 S-1, 30450 S-2, 30450 S-3 and 30450 S-4.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 2.23 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 500.0 acre-feet annually.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before:

May 27, 1999

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before:

June 27, 1999

Application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:

May 27, 2004

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:

June 27, 2004

Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before:

June 27, 2004

This application is being filed to appropriate effluent from the Carson City Wastewater Treatment Plant and pipeline for use on the Silver Oak Golf Course located in Carson City, Nevada. Said application is subject to the Agreement for Services entered into between Carson City and Silver Oak Development Corporation Limited Partnership on November 18, 1993 and submitted along with this application. Said agreement provides for the delivery of 500 acre-feet of treated effluent annually. Use will be limited to the Silver Oak Golf Course and other areas as indicated on the map filed in support of this application. Please utilize the map on file under Permit 30450 for the proposed point of diversion.
