The applicant Barmen Cattle Inc. of P. O. Box 12 County of Paradise Valley State of Nevada 89426, hereby makes application for permission to change the point of diversion ( a portion of ) of water heretofore appropriated under #28170

1. The source of water is underground (Name of stream, lake or other source.)

2. The amount of water to be changed 3 CFS (Second feet, acre feet.)

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the

following limitations and conditions: This permit is issued subject to existing rights. It is understood that the amount of water herein granted is only a temporary allowance and that the final water right obtained under this permit will be dependent upon the amount of water actually placed to beneficial use. It is also understood that this right must allow for a reasonable lowering of the static water level. This well shall be equipped with a two (2) inch opening for measuring depth to water. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. A substantial weir or other type of measuring device must be installed and measurements of water use kept. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer, pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

The total combined amount of water granted under this permit and Permit 24921 is limited to what the well covered under the two permits is capable of producing. If certificates of appropriation are issued under this permit and Permit 24921, the total combined amount of appropriation granted in said certificates shall not exceed what the well covered under the two permits is capable of producing.

The amount of water to be changed shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not

to exceed 3.0 cubic feet per second but not to exceed a yearly duty of 3.6 acre-feet per acre of land irrigated from any and/or all sources.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before March 17, 1977

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before April 17, 1977

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before March 17, 1977

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before April 17, 1977

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before December 19, 1979

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before January 19, 1980

Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before January 19, 1980
