APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to existing rights and is further subject to revocation if and when water can be furnished by an entity such as a water district or a municipality engaged in furnishing water. A totalizing meter must be installed in the discharge pipeline, near the point of diversion, and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. It is understood that this right must allow for a reasonable lowering of the static water level. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening for measuring depth to water. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.05 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 11.8 million gallons annually.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before October 9, 1977

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before November 9, 1977

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 9, 1977

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before November 9, 1977

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before October 9, 1979

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before November 9, 1979
