hereby make application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated.

5. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point: SW 1/4 of SW 1/4 of Sec. 9, T.16N.,

R. 21E., at a point from which the SW corner of said Sec. 9 bears S.

2° 44' West a distance of 820 feet.

6. Place of use Donovan Mill. Same 40 acre parcel as above, SW 1/4 of SW 1/4

of Sec. 9, T.16N., R. 21E.

7. Use will begin about Jan. 1st and end about Dec. 31st, of each year.

specifications of your diversion or storage works.) Drilled well - construct pump

house - install pump and power - pipe under highway to existing

water system of Donovan Mill.
