....., hereby make\$ application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation; if a copartnership or association, give names of members.) Applicant is a Corporation; incorporated in the State of Nevada on August 19, 1975.

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Wilson Spring

2. The amount of water applied for is 0.50 cfs second-foot

The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point: in the SW¹/₄NE¹/₄ section 25, T.45N., R.25E., MDB&M, or at a point from which the corner common to sections 13 and 24 and sections 18 and 19, T.45N., Ranges 25 and 26 it should be stated. E., MDB&M, bears N. 14° 32' 25" E. 7039.50 feet distant.

6. Place of use SW¹/₄NE¹/₄ Section 25, T.45N., R.25E., MDB&M.

7. Use will begin about January 1st and end about December 31st, of each year.

8. Description of proposed works. (Under the provisions of NRS 535.010 you may be required to submit plans and specifications of your diversion or storage works.) a sidehill spring is piped westerly to two storage tanks and from there southwesterly in an 1 1/2" pipe line to the places of use.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to all existing rights on the source. It is understood that the .50 c.f.s., herein granted is only a temporary allowance and that the final water right obtained under this permit will be dependent upon the amount of water actually placed to a beneficial use. A suitable measuring device must be installed and accurate measurements of the water placed to a beneficial use must be included in the proof of such use when filed. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed .5 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 0.156 million gallons annually.
