

APPLICATION FOR PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS OF THE STATE OF NEVADA

The applicant Black Springs General Improvement District
301 Kennedy Drive, of Reno
Nevada 89506, hereby make application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated.

- 1. The source of the proposed appropriation is underground
2. The amount of water applied for is 1.172 cfs
3. The water to be used for quasi-municipal and domestic
4. If use is for: N/A

5. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point: SE 1/4 SW 1/4 sec. 9, T20N, R19E.
MDM&M from existing well from which the SE corner of the SE 1/4 SW 1/4 of above sec 9 bears S 85° 22' 41" E; 1220.50 feet

6. Place of use a portion of the NE 1/4 of SW 1/4, SE 1/4 of SW 1/4, SW 1/4 of SW 1/4 NW 1/4 of SE 1/4, SW 1/4 of SE 1/4 of section 9 and a portion of the NW 1/4 of NW 1/4 and the NE 1/4 of NW 1/4 of section 16, T20N, R19E, MDB&M.

7. Use will begin about 1/1 and end about 12/31, of each year.

8. Description of proposed works. (Under the provisions of NRS 535.010 you may be required to submit plans and specifications of your diversion or storage works.) domestic distribution system consisting of transmission main, fire hydrants, booster pump, fire pump and storage reservoir (210,000 gal.) supplied by 2 wells.

12. Remarks: For use other than irrigation or stock watering, state number and type of units to be served or annual consumptive use.
 The system is already in place and serving 63 residences under permits numbered 30446 & 30366. Those permits allow a total of 34.044 million gallons per year to be appropriated but also purport to limit to 45 the number of residences to be served. This is to eliminate the 45 number limitation, if such a limitation exists, and to increase the limit to 140 residences, at 600 gallons per residential household per day or 93 households, at 1,000 gal. per household per day, at the permissible and authorized level of 34 million gallons of water, annually. See permits numbered 30366 and 30446.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to existing rights. It is understood that the amount of water herein granted is only a temporary allowance and that the final water right obtained under this permit will be dependent upon the amount of water actually placed to beneficial use. It is also understood that this right must allow for a reasonable lowering of the static water level. This well shall be equipped with a two (2) inch opening for measuring depth to water. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. A totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of water begins, or before the Proof of Completion of Work is filed. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer, pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.
 The total number of units to be served under Permits 30366, 30446 and 34012 is limited to the 63 units now being served and the total combined duty under this Permit and Permits 30366, 30446, and 34012 shall not exceed 23.65 million gallons annually.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed..... 0.1172..... cubic feet per second, but not to exceed..... 23.65 million gallons annually.....
