APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 26798 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 26798 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a measuring device must be installed in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

The total combined amount of water granted under this permit and Permits 26798, 34025, 35787, 35788, 35789, and 35790 is limited to what the well covered under the permits is capable of producing. If certificates of appropriation are issued under this permit and Permits 26798, 34025, 35787, 35788, 35789, and 35790, the total combined amount of appropriation granted in said certificates shall not exceed what the well covered under the permits is capable of producing.

The total combined number of acres allowed under this permit and Permits 34025, 35787, 35788, 35789, and 35790 shall not exceed 93.64 acres. The amount of water to be changed shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not

to exceed 0.90 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed a yearly duty of 4.0 acre-feet per acre of land irrigated from any and/or all sources.

- Actual construction work shall begin on or before September 20, 1979
- Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before October 20, 1979
- Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before September 20, 1979
- Proof of completion of work shall be filed before October 20, 1979
- Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before September 20, 1981
- Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before October 20, 1981
- Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before October 20, 1981
