hereby make application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated.

Incorporated January 2, 1975 in the State of Delaware

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Underground Well No. 11

2. The amount of water applied for is 3.25 second-feet

(a) If stored in reservoir give number of acre-feet

3. The water to be used for Industrial

4. If use is for:

(a) Irrigation (state number of acres to be irrigated)

(b) Stockwater (state number and kinds of animals to be watered)

(c) Other use (describe fully under "No. 12. Remarks")

(d) Power:

(1) Horsepower developed

(2) Point of return of water to stream

5. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point: SE 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 1, T.34N., R.23E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the witness corner for the W 1/2 corner of said Section 1 bears S 83° 00' W 1525.00 feet

6. Place of use Sections 1, 2, 3, 10, 11, 12, NW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 13, N 1/2 N 1/2 Sec. 14, N 1/2 N 1/2 Sec. 15, T.34N., R.23E., M.D.B. & M., W 1/2 Sec. 5 Sections 6 & 7 W 1/2 Sec. 8, T.34N., R.24E., M.D.B.&M., Sections 13, 14, 22, 23, 24, 25, 26, 27, 34, 35 and 36 T.35N., R.23E., M.D.B.&M., Sections 18, 19, 30, 31, W 1/2 Sec. 17 W 1/2 Sec. 20, W 1/2 Sec. 29 and W 1/2 Sec. 32 T.35N., R.24E., M.D.B. & M.

7. Use will begin about January 1 and end about December 31, of each year.

8. Description of proposed works. (Under the provisions of NRS 535.010 you may be required to submit plans and specifications of your diversion or storage works.) Drill well to approximately 6000 feet, install casing and cement back to surface to protect fresh water zones. Hot water of steam will flow through pipeline to electric plant.

- 9. Estimated cost of works.....\$500,000.00
- 10. Estimated time required to construct works..... 2 years
- 11. Estimated time required to complete the application to beneficial use..... 5 years
- 12. Remarks: For use other than irrigation or stock watering, state number and type of units to be served or annual consumptive use.

This application is for a geothermal well with a production of 2.1 million gallons per day. The withdrawal will be 2352 acre feet per year; however, the high temperature water would be flashed with the net effect of 210,000 gallons per day being beneficially used and the remaining water returned to the reservoir so only 235 acre feet per year is actually used. This application is comingled with other applications. The total hot water-steam equivalent necessary for beneficial use is 3300 acre feet per year from all applications.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to all existing rights on the source. It is understood that the amount of water herein granted is only a temporary allowance and that the final water right obtained under this permit will be dependent upon the amount of water actually placed to beneficial use. It is also understood that this right must allow for a reasonable lowering of the static water level at permittee's well due to other ground water development in the area. A measuring device must be installed and measurements of water use kept. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water granted herein at any and all times.

There are to be no perforations in the well for at least the first 5000 feet. The well is to be cemented from the 5000 foot level to the surface to protect fresh water zones. The total water - steam equivalent to be consumptively withdrawn from the geothermal ground water reservoir under Permits 34427 through 34443 is limited to 3300 acre-feet of water per year.

This permit is further issued subject to the condition that the power or energy generated by the beneficial use of this water or steam is subject to recapture and use within the boundaries of the State of Nevada when the need arises.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 3.25 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 235.0 acre-feet annually.

- Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before..... December 3, 1978
- Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before..... November 3, 1979
- Proof of completion of work shall be filed before..... December 3, 1979
- Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before..... November 3, 1984
- Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before..... December 3, 1984
- Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before..... December 3, 1984
