APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to all existing rights on the source. It is
understood that the amount of water herein granted is only a temporary allowance and
that the final water right obtained under this permit will be dependent upon the
period of use and the average number of livestock served from the waters of this
source. It is further understood that this right must allow for a reasonable lowering
of the static water level at permittee's well due to any other ground water development
in the area. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening for measuring depth to
water. If well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent
waste. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted
at any and all times but does not take responsibility for the use of the Federal
range.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.0047 cubic feet per second or sufficient water to
water 150 head of cattle.

- Actual construction work shall begin on or before July 10, 1980
- Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before August 10, 1980
- Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before July 10, 1981
- Proof of completion of work shall be filed before August 10, 1981
- Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before July 10, 1982
- Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before August 10, 1982
- Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before AUG 15 1980
