11. Description of proposed works.

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use: Works of diversion in Lot 12 Sec. 28, T.38N; R.70 E., and Lot 1, Sec. 33, T. 38N; R.70E., consists of stone masonry boxes placed in the excavations in the spring areas, back-filled with rubble rock and covered with earth. The water is conveyed in a southwesterly direction by means of 1107 feet of 2" galvanized iron pipe to a 4" main pipe line from Killian and other springs in the State of Utah. Work of diversion in Lot 6, Sec. 33, T. 38N; R. 70E., consist of a concrete box and the water is conveyed in a northwesterly direction by means of 940 feet of 2" galvanized iron pipe to the 4" Main Pipe Line mentioned above. The water from the above described diversions commingled with water flowing from the Killian and other springs in the State of Utah, is conveyed in a northwesterly direction, respectively thru 2154 feet of 4" pipe, 4492 feet of 6" pipe, 4252 feet of 4" pipe, 2528 feet of 6" pipe, and 50,530 feet of 8" pipe to a 350,000 gallon steel tank in Montello, Nevada located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 17, T. 39N; R. 69E. From the steel tank the water is distributed by a system of pipe lines to locomotive water columns, fire hydrants, railroad shops and other railroad facilities and dwellings.
