hereby make application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation; if a copartnership or association, give names of members.)

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is well Name of stream, lake or other source.

2. The amount of water applied for is 0.5 second-feet One second-foot equals 448.83 gals. per min.

(a) If stored in reservoir give number of acre-feet acre-feet

3. The water to be used for Quasi-Municipal and Domestic Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic, or other use.

4. If use is for: (a) Irrigation (state number of acres to be irrigated)

(c) Other use (describe fully under "No. 12. Remarks")

(d) Power: (1) Horsepower developed (2) Point of return of water to stream

5. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point: NW 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 17, T19N, R18E, MDB&M, or at a point from which the N 1/4 corner of said section 17 bears N 75° 24' 17" W 1,219.80 feet. Describe as being within a 40-acre subdivision of public survey, and by course and distance to a section corner. If on unsurveyed land, it should be stated.

6. Place of use portions of NW 1/4 NE 1/4, NE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 17, T19N, R18E, MDB&M (Thirteen Acres) Describe by legal subdivision, if on unsurveyed land it should be so stated.

7. Use will begin about January 1 and end about December 31, of each year. Day and Month Day and Month

8. Description of proposed works. (Under the provisions of NRS 535.010 you may be required to submit plans and specifications of your diversion or storage works.) Drill well, install pump and motor, pipelines and storage tank to serve development. State manner in which water is to be diverted, whether by dam or other works, whether through pipes, ditches, flumes, or other conduits.

- 11. Estimated time required to complete the application to beneficial use.....Five Years

A water system will be built to serve 220-condominium dwelling units, four-unit apartment and a single family residence.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to existing rights. It is understood that the amount of water herein granted is only a temporary allowance and that the final water right obtained under this permit will be dependent upon the amount of water actually placed to beneficial use. It is also understood that this right must allow for a reasonable lowering of the static water level. This well shall be equipped with a two (2) inch opening for measuring depth to water. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. A totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of water begins, or before the Proof of Completion of Work is filed. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer, pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.5 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 28.8 million gallons annually.

- Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before.....June 18, 1981
- Proof of completion of work shall be filed before.....July 18, 1981
- Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before.....June 18, 1984
- Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before.....July 18, 1984
- Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before.....
