The applicant Thomas J. Hall and Hubert R. Zemke, Jr.

89505, hereby make application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated.

T16N, R19E, MDB&M, or at a point from which the East 1/2 corner of said Section 9 bears S 83° 22' E, a distance of 1302 feet.

6. Place of use Lots 7, 8 and 11 of Franktown Hissl Subdivision No. 2 in

the E 1/2 NE 1/4, the SW 1/4 NE 1/4, and the NW 1/4 SE 1/4, all in section 9, T16N, R19E, MDB&M.

7. Use will begin about January 1 and end about December 31, of each year.

8. Description of proposed works. (Under the provisions of NRS 535.010 you may be required to submit plans and specifications of your diversion or storage works.) drilled well, transmission main to storage tanks, distribution system with metered service.

State manner in which water is to be diverted, whether by dam or other works, whether through pipes, ditches, flumes, or other conduits.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to existing rights. It is understood that the amount of water herein granted is only a temporary allowance and that the final water right obtained under this permit will be dependent upon the amount of water actually placed to beneficial use. It is also understood that this right must allow for a reasonable lowering of the static water level. This well shall be equipped with a two (2) inch opening for measuring depth to water. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. A totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of water begins, or before the Proof of Completion of Work is filed. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer, pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit is abrogated by Permit 35926. This permit is issued only to retain the date of priority of the original application. In the event of the cancellation or withdrawal of Permit 35926, no right will revert to this permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.613 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 7.3 million gallons annually.

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before N/A

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before July 10, 1982

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before August 10, 1982

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before July 10, 1985
