 The well may be used continuously in which case 1080 AC ft. would be diverted. The map or maps filed with 1st proof of appropriation under Applic. No. 7668 are by reference made a part hereof. The applicant had an approved application No. 20823 covering this well. The well was filled in by Nye County Road Dept. (see attached letter). This application is to reinstate that water right. Also this same well location is covered by Applic. No. 35717 filed in name of Zeno Mines to be used for mining purposes in Sec. 32 T.13N. R.39E. The well is located in Shamrock claims and Zeno Mines has agreed to withdraw its application on approval hereof as this filing will cover Zeno Mines uses as well as Shamrock Mines uses.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions: This permit is issued subject to existing rights. It is understood that the amount of water herein granted is only a temporary allowance and that the final water right obtained under this permit will be dependent upon the amount of water actually placed to beneficial use. It is also understood that this right must allow for a reasonable lowering of the static water level. This well shall be equipped with a two (2) inch opening for measuring depth to water. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. A totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of water begins or before the Proof of Completion of Work is filed.

The total combined rate of diversion issued under Permits 35890, 44366, 44367, 46638 and 46639 shall not exceed 4.189 c.f.s.

The total combined duty of water under Permits 35890, 44366, 44367, 46638 and 46639 shall not exceed 65.18 million gallons annually.

This Permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The manner of use of water under this permit is by nature of its activity a temporary use and any application to change the manner of use granted under this permit will be subject to additional determination and evaluation with respect to the permanent effects on existing rights and the resource within the ground water basin.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal, and local agencies.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 1.5 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 65.18 million gallons annually.
