The applicant Las Vegas Valley Water District, A Quasi-Municipal Corporation

hereby make application for permission to change the Point of Diversion, Manner of Use and Place of Use

of water heretofore appropriated under Permit No. 16039, Certificate No. 4953

(Identify existing right by Permit, Certificate, Proof or Claim Nos. If Decreed, give title of Decree and identify right in Decree.)

1. The source of water is underground - Las Vegas Artesian Basin

2. The amount of water to be changed 0.25 cfs, not to exceed 4.3 mg/yr

3. The water to be used for Quasi-Municipal and Domestic

4. The water heretofore used for Quasi-Municipal

5. The water is to be diverted at the following point located in NE 1/4 of the NE 1/4 of section 31, T.20S., R.61E., MDB&M, or at a point from which the NE corner of said section 31 bears N. 85° 43' 37" E. a distance of 1272.29 feet.

6. The existing point of diversion is located within the SE 1/4 of the NE 1/4 of the NE 1/4 of section 21, T.20S., R.62E., MDB&M, or at a point from which the NE corner of said Section 21 bears N. 61° 55' 54" W. a distance of 2,535 feet.

7. Proposed place of use is the area included within the Las Vegas Valley Water District as denoted by Chapter 167, Statutes of Nevada, 1947, as it now exists or as it may hereafter be amended.

8. Existing place of use N 1/2 NE 1/4 Section 21, T.20S., R.62E., MDB&M.

9. Use will be from 1st January to 31st December of each year.

10. Use has been from 1st January to 31st December of each year.

11. Description of proposed works. (Under the provisions of NRS 535.010 you may be required to submit plans and specifications of your diversion or storage works.) water is to be diverted from an existing 16" diameter cased well approximately 1,014 feet deep, known as Las Vegas Valley Water District Well No. 14, Main Well Field, via an existing deep well pump, pipelines, reservoirs and distribution system.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion, manner, and place of use of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 16039, Certificate 4953, is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 16039, Certificate 4953, and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

The amount of water to be changed shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed..... 0.25..... cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 4.3 million gallons annually.
