6. Place of use Within the boundaries of the applicant's lode mining claims in Township 11 South, Range 46 East, MDB&M., Sections 23, 24, 25, 26, 34, 35 & 36 and Township 12 South, Range 46 East, MDB&M., Sections 1, 2, 3, 10, and 11.
