The applicant W. Dalton La Rue, Sr. & Juanita S. La Rue, dba Winnemucca Ranch P.O. Box 3159, of Reno Nevada 89505, hereby make application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated.

(If applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation; if a copartnership or association, give names of members.)

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Unnamed springs in the Upper Milk Ranch

These natural irrigated meadows and ditches have been fenced and used each and every year since 1859 and appear on the first plat survey of 1867. Application #11825 and 17830 Certificate #5021, or, Application 11827 Certificate #4966 failed to include these springs and the area of use. There is no way to increase or decrease the area. By this application we do not waive our vested water rights on this land prior to 1905.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to all existing rights on the source. A substantial headgate and measuring device must be installed and maintained to facilitate the measurement and control of water. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This Permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The total combined duty of water under Permits 17830, 36643, 36644, 36645 and 36646 shall not exceed 163.4 acre-feet annually.
