This water storage and the area of use is the same as on Application #11827 and Certificate #4966. This area was part of Application #4420 (1917) and Application #6958 (8/24/23) as "Vested Water Rights Known as Milk Ranch Reservoir and Water Right". This water had been put to beneficial use prior to the time of the first geological survey in 1867. See original plat map of T24N R19E MDB&M and engineers notes. This is the main tributary of Upper Dry Valley Creek. By this application we do not waive our vested water rights on this land prior to 1905.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to all existing rights on the source. A substantial headgate and measuring device must be installed and maintained to facilitate the measurement and control of water. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

The total combined duty of water under Permits 11827, 17830 and 36647 shall not exceed 515.2 acre-feet annually.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 2.0 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed a yearly duty of 4.0 acre-feet per acre of land irrigated from any and/or all sources.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before.....

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before April 19, 1989
