The applicant..... Nye County Development Co., Inc., c/o Mr. Steve Honig /Broadway Anglo Fabrics Co., Inc., 1407, of New York, New York 10018, hereby make s. application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated.
