hereby make application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation; if a copartnership or association, give names of members.)

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Spring No. 21

2. The amount of water applied for is 0.5 cfs second-feet

(a) If stored in reservoir give number of acre-feet

3. The water to be used for Stockwater

4. If use is for: (a) Irrigation (state number of acres to be irrigated)

(b) Stockwater (state number and kinds of animals to be watered) 500 - 1000 Cattle

(c) Other use (describe fully under "No. 12. Remarks")

(d) Power: (1) Horsepower developed (2) Point of return of water to stream

5. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point: SE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 22, T38N, R64E, MDB&M., at a point from which the SE Corner of said Section 22 bears S 22° 00' 00" E 535.97 feet.

6. Place of use SE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 22, T38N, R64E, MDB&M.

7. Use will begin about January 1 and end about December 31, of each year.

8. Description of proposed works. (Under the provisions of NRS 535.010 you may be required to submit plans and specifications of your diversion or storage works.) Improved Spring & Open Ditch.

State manner in which water is to be diverted, whether by dam or other works, whether through pipes, ditches, flumes, or other conduits.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to all existing rights on the source. It is understood that the amount of water herein granted is only a temporary allowance and that the final water right obtained under this permit will be dependent upon the period of use and the average number of livestock served from the waters of this source. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times but does not take responsibility for the use of the Federal range.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.0312 cubic feet per second, or sufficient water to water 1,000 head of cattle.
