Nev 89507, hereby make application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation; if a copartnership or association, give names of members.)

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is run off and drainage water from an unnamed creek traversing through a 100 ft. drainage easement.

2. The amount of water applied for is .01 second-feet

(a) If stored in reservoir give number of acre-feet 1/4 ac. feet acre-feet

3. The water to be used for fish, fowl and recreation

4. If use is for: (a) Irrigation (state number of acres to be irrigated)

(b) Stockwater (state number and kinds of animals to be watered)

5. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point: from the northwest corner of the property of lot 8 into a 50' x 75' pond (within lot 8) adjacent to drainage easement and then to return to the original drainage easement location.

6. Place of use Lot 8, the Frost Ranches, Washoe Co. Nev., aka 3560 Lunsford Ct., Reno. S 1/2 of SE 1/4 of Section 2, T18N, R19E, MDB&M.

7. Use will begin about year around and end about, of each year.

8. Description of proposed works. (Under the provisions of NRS 535.010 you may be required to submit plans and specifications of your diversion or storage works.) The water will be diverted through a pipe to the pond and returned to the same drainage easement area through a pipe or spillway overpond.

9. Estimated cost of works..... \$1,000

10. Estimated time required to construct works..... 1 month

11. Estimated time required to complete the application to beneficial use..... 4 months

The water is from storm run-off, flood flows and natural springs along drainage easement, and passes through our property located in the Frost Ranches off Lakeside Drive in Reno.
