hereby make application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated.

2. The amount of water applied for is 5.4 cfs second-foot

6. Place of use W 1/2 of Sec. 1, T.15S., R.67E., MDM.

7. Use will begin about Jan. 1 and end about Dec. 31, of each year.

8. Description of proposed works. (Under the provisions of NRS 535.010 you may be required to submit plans and specifications of your diversion or storage works.) Drilled and cased well to sufficient depth to produce water and install sprinkler system of laterals and ditches to irrigate lands.
