#### APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to all existing rights on the source. It is understood that the 5.0 cubic feet per second herein granted is only a temporary allowance and that the final water right obtained under this permit will be dependent upon the amount of water actually placed to a beneficial use. A suitable measuring device must be installed upstream and downstream of Cave Lake Reservoir and accurate measurements of the water placed to a beneficial use must be included in the proof of such use when filed. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

This permit is subject to the condition that the permittee must ensure that wildlife which has customarily used such water will have access thereto, NRS 533.367.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

Monthly records shall be kept of the inflow of Cave Creek in cubic feet per second into Cave Creek reservoir and the outflow of Cave Creek in cubic feet per second from Cave Creek reservoir and the annual records submitted to the State Engineer on or before February 15th of each year.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, **and not to exceed 5.0 cubic feet per second and not to exceed 784 acre-feet annually of storage.**

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before:

April 27, 2010

Water must be placed to beneficial use and proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:


