This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the place of use of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 26912 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 26912 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a measuring device must be installed in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

No perforations shall be put in the casing until after the well is completed and the log available for study. Perforations shall not start less than 100 feet from the surface unless the log shows a satisfactory confining formation nearer the surface.

The point of diversion of Permit 26912 is not changed by this permit.

The place of use under this permit is limited to the following 273.3 acres as shown on the amended supporting map filed December 13, 1979, under 38225:

1.6 acres in SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, 19.3 acres in SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, 15.4 acres in SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, 31.7 acres in SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 22; 1.5 acres in SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 23; 12.4 acres in NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, 33.3 acres in NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, 22.1 acres in NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, 39.8 acres in SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, 24.5 acres in SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$.
