hereby make application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation; if a copartnership or association, give names of members.) none

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Silver Park Spring
Name of stream, lake, spring, underground or other source

2. The amount of water applied for is one second-foot

5. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point: SE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 20, T7N, R68E, M.D.B.&M. unsurveyed, or at a point from which the SE corner of Section 32, T7N, R68E, bears South 40 15' East a distance of 11,790 feet in Lincoln County, Nevada

6. Place of use SE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 20, T7N, R68E, M.D.B.&M. unsurveyed

7. Use will begin about January 1 and end about December 31, of each year.

8. Description of proposed works. (Under the provisions of NRS 535.010 you may be required to submit plans and specifications of your diversion or storage works.) Works of diversion. This source consists of a live spring with a drainage in a north-easterly direction. The subject water will be collected and used in placer washing operations at the place of use.
State manner in which water is to be diverted, i.e. diversion structure, ditches and flumes, drilled well with pump and motor, etc.

9. Estimated cost of works \$13,500.00

10. Estimated time required to construct works two years
If well completed, describe works.

Subject water will be used for mining and milling purposes by applicant in the development and operation of two placer and three lode claims in the area immediately surrounding the point of diversion. This will consist primarily of washing operations via sluice boxes within 200 yards of the Silver Park Spring. I anticipate the annual rate of consumption at peak operation will be 192,000 gallons

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to all existing rights on the source. It is understood that the 0.03 c.f.s., herein granted is only a temporary allowance and that the final water right obtained under this permit will be dependent upon the amount of water actually placed to a beneficial use. A suitable measuring device must be installed and accurate measurements of the water placed to a beneficial use must be included in the proof of such use when filed. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This Permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

This permit is subject to the condition that the permittee must ensure that wildlife which have customarily used such water will have access thereto, NRS 533.367.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal, and local agencies.

This permit is issued specifically subject to the stockwatering rights of Murray Sheep Company or Imperial Farms Land and Cattle Company as evidenced by Application No. 7161, Certificate No. 1950.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.03 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 6.0 million gallons annually.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before January 8, 1986

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before February 8, 1986

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before January 8, 1989

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before February 8, 1989

Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before
