The applicant Gary B. Marriott, Richard L. Loudin, Sara L. Loudin, Robin K. Loudin 2109 San Jose Ave, of Las Vegas Nevada 89109, hereby make application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated.

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Las Vegas Artesian Basin (underground) Name of stream, lake or other source.

2. The amount of water applied for is 4 residences @ .00223 second-feet One second-foot equals 448.83 gals. per min.



The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point: NE 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 36 T19S R59E MDB&M or at a point from which the N 1/4 corner of said section 36 bears North 74 48' 17" East a distance of 1361.83 feet Describe as being within a 40-acre subdivision of public survey, and by course and distance to a section corner. If on unsurveyed land, it should be stated.

6. Place of use a portion of the W 1/2 NW 1/4 NE 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 36 T19S R59E MDB&M Describe by legal subdivision, if on unsurveyed land it should be so stated.

7. Use will begin about January 1 and end about December 31, of each year. Month and Day Month and Day

8. Description of proposed works. APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to existing rights and is further subject to revocation if and when water can be furnished by an entity such as a water district or a municipality engaged in furnishing water. A totalizing meter must be installed in the discharge pipeline, near the point of diversion, and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. It is understood that this right must allow for a reasonable lowering of the static water level. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening for measuring depth to water. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.00223 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 1.46 million gallons annually.
