(If applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation; if a copartnership or association, give names of members.)

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Peavine Campground Spring Name of stream, lake or other source.

2. The amount of water applied for is .015 second-feet One second-foot equals 448.83 gals. per min.



5. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point: NW 1/4 NW 1/4 NE 1/4, Section 30, T.9 N., R.42 E., M.D.B. and M., an unsurveyed township, bearing South 24° 45' East at 17,300 feet from the Southeast corner of Section 5, T.8 N., R.42 E., it should be stated. M.D.B. and M.

6. Place of use NW 1/4 NW 1/4 NE 1/4, Section 30, T.9 N., R.42 E., M.D.B. and M., an unsurveyed township. Describe by legal subdivision, if on unsurveyed land it should be so stated.

7. Use will begin about April 1 and end about November 30, of each year. Month and Day Month and Day

8. Description of proposed works. (Under the provisions of NRS 535.010 you may be required to submit plans and specifications of your diversion or storage works.) Headbox and adjacent campground water system. Campground is adjacent to source and point of diversion. State manner in which water is to be diverted, whether by dam or other works, whether through pipes, ditches, flumes, or other conduits.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to all existing rights on the source. It is understood that the 0.15 c.f.s., herein granted is only a temporary allowance and that the final water right obtained under this permit will be dependent upon the amount of water actually placed to a beneficial use. A suitable measuring device must be installed and accurate measurements of the water placed to a beneficial use must be included in the proof of such use when filed. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed..... 0.15 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 0.2 acre-feet annually.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before..... February 2, 1981
 Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before..... March 2, 1981
 Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before..... February 2, 1981
