The applicant Geo. Eldridge and Son, Inc.

89301, hereby make application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated.

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Underground Well No. 2

2. The amount of water applied for is 10.8 cfs second-feet

(a) If stored in reservoir give number of acre-feet acre-feet

3. The water to be used for Irrigation and Domestic

4. If use is for:

(a) Irrigation (state number of acres to be irrigated) 735 acres

(b) Stockwater (state number and kinds of animals to be watered)

(2) Point of return of water to stream

5. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point: in the SE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section

26, T.19N., R.66E., MDB&M, whence the Northeast corner of said section 26 bears N.10°29'56"E, 4842.69 feet distant.

6. Place of use SW 1/4 of Section 25; portions of E 1/2 SE 1/4 of Section 26;

portions of E 1/2 E 1/2 of Section 35; NW 1/4, W 1/2 SW 1/4 of Section 36, T.19N., R.66E., MDB&M, N 1/2 NW 1/4, NW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 1; portions of the NE 1/4 NE 1/4 of section 2, T.18N., R.66E., MDB&M.

7. Use will begin about January 1st and end about December 31st, of each year.

8. Description of proposed works. (Under the provisions of NRS 535.010 you may be required to submit plans and specifications of your diversion or storage works.) Water will be pumped into "V" ditches and then flood irrigated.
