hereby make application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation; if a copartnership or association, give names of members.)

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is the Las Vegas underground aquifer Name of stream, lake or other source.

2. The amount of water applied for is 0.050 second-feet One second-foot equals 448.83 gals. per min.

(a) If stored in reservoir give number of acre-feet acre-feet

3. The water to be used for Industrial and domestic uses Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic, or other use. Must limit to one use.

4. If use is for:



5. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point: located in the SE 1/4 of SW 1/4, Sec 32, T19S R62E, MDM, Clark County, Nevada from which the South-east corner of said section 32 bears S 46° 10' 44" W 1,891.70 feet. Describe as being within a 40-acre subdivision of public survey, and by course and distance to a section corner. If on unsurveyed land, it should be stated.

6. Place of use the NW 1/4 of SE 1/4 of SW 1/4, the W 1/2 NE 1/4 SW 1/4, the NW 1/4 of SW 1/4, the SW 1/4 of NW 1/4 and the W 1/2 of SE 1/4 of NW 1/4, all in Sec 32, T19S R62E, MDM. Describe by legal subdivision, if on unsurveyed land it should be so stated.

7. Use will begin about Jan 1 and end about Dec 31, of each year. Month and Day

8. Description of proposed works. (Under the provisions of NRS 535.010 you may be required to submit plans and specifications of your diversion or storage works.) 10" well, 500 ft deep, with 100 gpm pump (deep well turbine) into distribution system. State manner in which water is to be diverted, whether by dam or other works, whether through pipes, ditches, flumes, or other conduits.

- 10. Estimated time required to construct works ..... six months
- 11. Estimated time required to complete the application to beneficial use ..... one year

Reference is made to previous application 30207. Water is to be used for processing ore transported to site, for domestic uses at offices in vicinity and for processing of salvaged and salvageable metals and material.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to existing rights and is further subject to revocation if and when water can be furnished by an entity such as a water district or a municipality engaged in furnishing water. A totalizing meter must be installed in the discharge pipeline, near the point of diversion, and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. It is understood that this right must allow for a reasonable lowering of the static water level. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening for measuring depth to water. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.05 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 11.8 million gallons annually.

- Actual construction work shall begin on or before February 14, 1981
- Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before March 14, 1981
- Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before February 14, 1982
- Proof of completion of work shall be filed before March 14, 1982
- Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before February 14, 1984
- Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before March 14, 1984
- Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before
