APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to existing rights. It is understood that the amount of water herein granted is only a temporary allowance and that the final water right obtained under this permit will be dependent upon the amount of water actually placed to beneficial use. It is also understood that this right must allow for a reasonable lowering of the static water level. This well shall be equipped with a two (2) inch opening for measuring depth to water. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. A totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of water begins, or before the Proof of Completion of Work is filed. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer, pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

The total combined amount of water granted under this permit and Permit 26673, Certificate 9552, is limited to what the well covered under the two permits is capable of producing. If certificates of appropriation are issued under this permit and Permit 26673, Certificate 9552, the total combined amount of appropriation granted in said certificates shall not exceed what the well covered under the two permits is capable of producing.

The total combined duty of water under this permit and Permit 26673, Certificate 9552, shall not exceed 76.468 million gallons annually.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 4.0 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 76.468 million gallons annually.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before N/A

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before N/A

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before December 22, 1983

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before January 22, 1984

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before December 22, 1986
