Nevada 89503 hereby make s application for permission to change the

point of diversion of a portion

of water heretofore appropriated under Permit Numer 29242

(Identify existing right by Permit, Certificate, Proof or Claim Nos. If Decreed, give title of Decree and identify right in Decree.)

1. The source of water is underground

2. The amount of water to be changed 1.0 cfs

3. The water to be used for quasi-municipal, domestic

4. The water heretofore used for quasi-municipal, domestic

5. The water is to be diverted at the following point within the SE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 35, T19N, R19E, MDB&M, from which the NE corner of Section 35 bears North 31° 58'42" East 1743.3 feet.

6. The existing point of diversion is located within the NE 1/4 NE 1/4, Section 35, T19N, R19E, MDB&M, from which the NE corner of said Section 35 bears N 24° 35' 21" E a distance of 189.09 feet


7. Proposed place of use the NW 1/4 of the NE 1/4, 28.0 acres in the SW 1/4 of the NE 1/4, 36.4 acres in the SE 1/4 of the NE 1/4, 12.4 acres in the NW 1/4 of the SE 1/4, and 36.4 acres in the NE 1/4 of the SE 1/4 along with a portion of the West 1/2 of Section 35, Township 19North, Range 19East, MDB&M as follows: 8.8 acres in the SW 1/4 of the NW 1/4, 39.7 acres in the NW 1/4 of the SW 1/4, and 11.0 acres in the NE 1/4 of the SW 1/4

8. Existing place of use same as above

9. Use will be from January 1 to December 31 of each year

10. Use has been from January 1 to December 31 of each year

11. Description of proposed works. (Under the provisions of NRS 535.010 you may be required to submit plans and specifications of your diversion or storage works.) The water is to be diverted through a pumping system, through a pressure force main to a storage tank and then a gravity distribution system.



- 12. Estimated cost of works.....1,000,000
- 13. Estimated time required to construct works.....6 months
- 14. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use.....3 years
- 15. Remarks: For use other than irrigation or stock watering, state number and type of units to be served or annual consumptive use.

This water is to serve 550 dwellings. Total diversion from all four points of diversion shall not exceed that allowed under Permit No. 29242 and application nos. 40505 & 40506.

 APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 29242 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 29242 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

The total combined duty of water under this permit and Permits 29242, 40505, and 40506 shall not exceed 200.75 million gallons annually.

The total diversion rate of this permit and Permits 29242, 40505, and 40506 shall not exceed a combined rate of 2.0 c.f.s.

The amount of water to be changed shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 1.0 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 200.75 million gallons annually.

- Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before.....March 15, 1981
- Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before.....February 15, 1982
- Proof of completion of work shall be filed before.....March 15, 1982
- Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before.....February 15, 1985
- Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before.....March 15, 1985
- Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before.....
