1. The source of water is Lake Tahoe Name of stream, lake, underground, spring or other source.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the place of use of the waters of Lake Tahoe heretofore granted under Permit 20850, Certificate 7761, is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 20850, Certificate 7761, and with the understanding that no other rights at the source shall be affected by the change proposed herein. A totalizing meter must be installed in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to a beneficial use. This permit is subject to the final allocation of the State of Nevada under the California-Nevada-Interstate Compact Commission. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

The total combined duty of water under this permit and Permit 40515 shall not exceed 1,250.0 acre-feet per annum.

The amount of water to be changed shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 5.0 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 1,250.0 acre-feet annually.

- Actual construction work shall begin on or before May 12, 1981
- Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before June 12, 1981
- Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before May 12, 1982
- Proof of completion of work shall be filed before June 12, 1982
- Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before May 12, 1985
- Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before June 12, 1985
