The applicant **Bureau of Land Management** hereby make1 application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is **Underground – Button Lake Well**
2. The amount of water applied for is **0.011 second-feet**
 - (a) If stored in reservoir give number of acre-feet
3. The water to be used for **Wildlife and Livestock**
4. If use is for:
 - (a) Irrigation, state number of acres to be irrigated
 - (b) Stockwater, state number and kinds of animals to be watered **800 Cattle and 40 Antelope**
 - (c) Other use (describe fully under No. 12. "Remarks")
 - (d) Power:
 - (1) Horsepower developed
 - (2) Point of return of water to stream
5. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point: **NW¼ SE¼ Section 25, T44N, R44E, M.D.M., Unsurveyed Township, or from a point from which the Southwest corner of Section 18, T45N, R43E, M.D.M. bears, N 55° 31' 07" W 58, 723.5 feet**
6. Place of Use **NW¼ SE¼ of Section 25, T44N, R44E, M.D.M. Unsurveyed**
7. Use will begin about **1 January** and end about **31 December** of each year.
8. Description of proposed works **Windmill, 7-inch casing, 2000 gallon stock trough.**
9. Estimated cost of works **\$19,424.00**
10. Estimated time required to construct works **3.0 man-months**
11. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use **Application was immediately after job completion.**

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to all existing rights on the source. It is understood that the amount of water herein granted is only a temporary allowance and that the final water right obtained under this permit will be dependent upon the period of use and the average number of animals served from the waters of this source. It is further understood that this right must allow for a reasonable lowering of the static water level at permittee's well due to any other ground water development in the area. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening for measuring depth to water. If well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times but does not take responsibility for the use of the Federal range.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The amount of water to be changed shall be limited to the amount, which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.0003 cubic feet per second, **or sufficient to water 40 antelope.**

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before:
May 30, 2007

Proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before:
June 30, 2007

Water must be placed to beneficial use on or before:
May 30, 2008

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:
June 30, 2008
