The applicant State of Nevada, Department of Conservation & Natural Resources, Division of State Parks, 1923 North Carson Street, Capitol Complex of Carson City, Nevada (89710), hereby make application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation; if a copartnership or association, give names of members.)

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Spring, Kershaw-Ryan #1 Name of stream, lake or other source.

2. The amount of water applied for is 0.025 second-feet One second-foot equals 448.83 gals. per min.

3. The water to be used for Recreation Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic, or other use. Must limit to one use.

The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point: NE1/4 NE1/4 Section 19, T4S, R67E, M.D.M., or at a point from which the Northwest corner of Section 18, T4S, R67E, M.D.M. bears, N 37° 36' 34" W 7696.18 feet Describe as being within a 40-acre subdivision of public survey, and by course and distance to a section corner. If on unsurveyed land, it should be stated.

6. Place of use NE1/4, E1/2 NW1/4, Section 19, T4S, R67E, M.D.M. Describe by legal subdivision, if on unsurveyed land it should be so stated.

7. Use will begin about January 1 and end about December 31, of each year. Month and Day Month and Day

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to all existing rights on the source. It is understood that the 0.025 c.f.s., herein granted is only a temporary allowance and that the final water right obtained under this permit will be dependent upon the amount of water actually placed to a beneficial use. A suitable measuring device must be installed and accurate measurements of the water placed to a beneficial use must be included in the proof of such use when filed. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This Permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

This permit is subject to the condition that the permittee must ensure that wildlife which have customarily used such water will have access thereto, NRS 533.367.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.025 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 5.9 million gallons annually.
