hereby make application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated.

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is unnamed spring
Name of stream, lake or other source.

2. The amount of water applied for is 0.10 cfs second-feet
One second-foot equals 448.83 gals. per min.

(a) If stored in reservoir give number of acre-feet acre-feet

3. The water to be used for irrigation and domestic
Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic, or other use. Must limit to one use.

5. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point: Beginning at the NW corner of Section 4, T22N, R22E; thence N 44° 30' 00" W 8448 feet, within the NW 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec 10, T22N, R22E, MDB&M
Describe as being within a 40-acre subdivision of public survey, and by course and distance to a section corner. If on unsurveyed land, it should be stated.

6. Place of use Within T22N, R22E, MDB&M and within a portion of the SE 1/4 Section 4, and a portion of the SW 1/4 of Section 3 and a portion of NE 1/4 of Section 3 and a portion of the W 1/2 NW 1/4 of Section 2 and a portion of the SE 1/4 of Section 3 and a portion of the NE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 9 and a portion of the NW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 10, portion of NW 1/4 of S. 3.

7. Use will begin about January 1 and end about December 31, of each year.
