Texas, 75202, hereby make application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated.

- 1. The source of the proposed appropriation is underground geotherman resource.
2. The amount of water applied for is Five (5) second-feet
3. The water to be used for temporary geothermal well testing.
4. If use is for: (a) Irrigation (state number of acres to be irrigated)
5. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point SE1/4NE1/4, Sec. 23, T.22N., R.63E., M.D.M., White Pine County.
6. Place of use SE1/4NE1/4, Sec. 23, T.22N., R 63E., M.D.M.

- 7. Use will begin about January 1 and end about December 31, of each year.
8. Description of proposed works. (Under the provisions of NRS 535.010 you may be required to submit plans and specifications of your diversion or storage works.) Water will be diverted from wellhead through pipes into test equipment and into reserve pits on drill pad.








Schellbourne No. 74-23




