hereby make application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation; if a copartnership or association, give names of members.) December 1978, Reno, Nevada

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Underground Well Number 1

2. The amount of water applied for is one second-foot

Excepting therefrom 12 acres lying North and West of Steamboat Ditch as described in a Deed recorded in Book 18, page 280, Deed Records. Township 19 North, Range 18 East, M.D.B.&M., Section 16; the Southwest quarter of the Southwest quarter. Township 19 North, Range 18 East, M.D.B.&M., Section 20; the East half, the East half of the Northwest quarter, and the Northeast quarter of the Southwest quarter. 7. Use will begin about January 1 and end about December 31, of each year.
