Nevada 89120, hereby make application for permission to appropriate the public

waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation; if a copartnership or association, give names of members.)

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Underground
Name of stream, lake or other source.

2. The amount of water applied for is 5.4 second-feet
One second-foot equals 448.83 gals. per min.
(a) If stored in reservoir give number of acre-feet acre-feet

3. The water to be used for Irrigation and Domestic
Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic, or other use. Must limit to one use.

4. If use is for:
(a) Irrigation (state number of acres to be irrigated) 320 acres
(b) Stockwater (state number and kinds of animals to be watered)
(c) Other use (describe fully under "No. 12. Remarks")
(d) Power:
(1) Horsepower developed
(2) Point of return of water to stream

5. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point: in the SW 1/4 of the NE 1/4 of Section 30, Township 12 North, Range 67 East, Mount Diablo Meridian, White Pine County, Nevada, from which the SW corner of Section 30, Township 12 North, Range 67 East, bears South 45° 00' West a distance of 5600 feet.

6. Place of use The East Half of Section 30, Township 12 North, Range 67 East, Mount Diablo Meridian, White Pine County, Nevada.

7. Use will begin about January 1 and end about December 31, of each year.

8. Description of proposed works. (Under the provisions of NRS 535.010 you may be required to submit plans and specifications of your diversion or storage works.) Drilled well with pump and pivot irrigation system, or an underground irrigation system in some portions where necessary.
