hereby make application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation; if a copartnership or association, give names of members.) Nevada 1972

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is underground Name of stream, lake or other source.

2. The amount of water applied for is 5.4 second-feet One second-foot equals 448.83 gals. per min.

bears S.45°W. 283 ft. Describe as being within a 40-acre subdivision of public survey, and by course and distance to a section corner. If on unsurveyed land, it should be stated.

6. Place of use SW 1/4, S 1/2 NW 1/4 Sec. 29, T.13N., R.43E. MDB&M Describe by legal subdivision, if on unsurveyed land it should be so stated.

7. Use will begin about January 1 and end about December 31, of each year. Month and Day

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to existing rights. It is understood that the amount of water herein granted is only a temporary allowance and that the final water right obtained under this permit will be dependent upon the amount of water actually placed to beneficial use. It is also understood that this right must allow for a reasonable lowering of the static water level. This well shall be equipped with a two (2) inch opening for measuring depth to water. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. A substantial weir or other type of measuring device must be installed and measurements of water use kept. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer, pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This Permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal, and local agencies.

The issuance of this permit limits the place of use to 160.00 acres within the SW 1/4 of Section 29, T.13N., R.43E., M.D.B.&M.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 2.7 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed a yearly duty of 4.0 acre-feet per acre of land irrigated from any and/or all sources.
