hereby make application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated.

- 1. The source of the proposed appropriation is underground
2. The amount of water applied for is 0.69 second-feet
(a) If stored in reservoir give number of acre-feet
3. The water to be used for Quasi-Municipal (Subdivision, Commercial) and Domestic
4. If use is for:
(a) Irrigation, state number of acres to be irrigated:

(d) Power:
(1) Horsepower developed
(2) Point of return of water to stream

5. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point: in the SW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 12, T. 25S., R. 59E., MDB&M or at a point whence the SW Corner of said Section 12 bears S. 67° 52' 30" W. a distance of 1155 feet.

6. Place of use Portions of the SE 1/4 NW 1/4 NE 1/4 SW 1/4 SE 1/4 SW 1/4 NW 1/4 SW 1/4 and the SW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 12, T. 25S., R. 59E., MDB&M and a portion of the SE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 11, T. 25S., R. 59E., MDB&M

7. Use will begin about January 1 and end about December 31, of each year.

8. Description of proposed works. (Under the provisions of NRS 535.010 you may be required to submit plans and specifications of your diversion or storage works.) Well, Pump & Motor, Pipelines, Reverse Osmosis Unit, Chlorination Facility, Storage tank and pipelines to place (s) of use.

9. Estimated cost of works \$350,000

10. Estimated time required to construct works 2 Years
If well completed, describe works.

11. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use 2 Years

12. Remarks: For use other than irrigation or stock watering, state number and type of units to be served or annual consumptive use.

Water will be used for proposed increased commercial development, casino expansion, increased single & multi-family housing development, a proposed R.V. camping park and a proposed permanent resident trailer park together with increased fire protection facilities.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to existing rights. It is understood that the amount of water herein granted is only a temporary allowance and that the final water right obtained under this permit will be dependent upon the amount of water actually placed to beneficial use. It is also understood that this right must allow for a reasonable lowering of the static water level. This well shall be equipped with a two (2) inch opening for measuring depth to water. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. A totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water place to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of water begins, or before the Proof of Completion of Work is filed. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer, pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This Permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

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The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.69 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 162.77 million gallons annually.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before March 7, 1990

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before April 7, 1990

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before March 7, 1993

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before April 7, 1993

Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before N/A
