

APPLICATION FOR PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS OF THE STATE OF NEVADA

The applicant Desert Valley Sod Farm, Inc.

Post Office Box 20065, of Reno, Nevada (89515), hereby make application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation; if a copartnership or association, give names of members.)

Incorporated in the State of Nevada on July 19, 1979.

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Underground Well No. 2

2. The amount of water applied for is 2.03 second-feet

(a) If stored in reservoir give number of acre-feet

3. The water to be used for Irrigation and Domestic

4. If use is for:

(a) Irrigation, state number of acres to be irrigated: 210-acres

(b) Stockwater, state number and kinds of animals to be watered:

(c) Other use (describe fully under "No. 12. Remarks")

(d) Power:

(1) Horsepower developed

(2) Point of return of water to stream

5. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point: NE 1/4 NW 1/4 (Lot 3) Section 6,

T35N, R37E, MDM or at a point from which the N 1/2 corner of said Section 6 bears N 15° 24' E, a distance of 1,360 feet.

6. Place of use 160 acres ± within the NW 1/4, 66.8 acres ± within the SW 1/4 and 129.1

acres ± in the NE 1/4, 3 acres ± within NW 1/4 SE 1/4, all in Section 6, T35N, R37E, MDM, lying North of the Railroad Tracks within said Section 6.

7. Use will begin about April 1 and end about October 31, of each year.

8. Description of proposed works. (Under the provisions of NRS 535.010 you may be required to submit plans and specifications of your diversion or storage works.) Drill well, install pump and motor and pipeline to sprinkler system to be used for irrigation.

9. Estimated cost of works In excess of \$100,000

10. Estimated time required to construct works..... One Year
If well completed, describe works.

11. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use..... Three Years

12. Remarks: For use other than irrigation or stock watering, state number and type of units to be served or annual consumptive use.

This application is being made to increase the rate of flow from 1.99 cfs to 4.02 cfs under Permit No. 39995. The total diversion will not exceed the amount allowed under Permit No. 39995. The rate of flow is necessary to operate a sprinkler system.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to existing rights. It is understood that the amount of water herein granted is only a temporary allowance and that the final water right obtained under this permit will be dependent upon the amount of water actually placed to beneficial use. It is also understood that this right must allow for a reasonable lowering of the static water level. This well shall be equipped with a two (2) inch opening for measuring depth to water. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. A substantial weir or other type of measuring device must be installed and measurements of water use kept. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer, pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit is issued subject to the terms and conditions set forth in the stipulation between Desert Valley Sod Farms, Inc. and the State Engineer dated November 30, 1984.

The total combined diversion rate under Permits 39995, Certificate 10576; and 42888 shall be limited to 4.02 c.f.s.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 2.03 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed a seasonal duty of 4.0 acre-feet per acre of land irrigated from any and/or all sources.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 2, 1985

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before November 2, 1985

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before April 2, 1986

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before May 2, 1986

Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before May 2, 1986
