

APPLICATION FOR PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS OF THE STATE OF NEVADA

The applicant Bureau of Land Management, Battle Mountain District P. O. Box 194, of Battle Mountain Nevada 89820, hereby make application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated.

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Underground Name of stream, lake or other source.

2. The amount of water applied for is .1 second-foot One second-foot equals 448.83 gals. per min.

R. 51 E. M.D.B. & M. Tie: N. 55° 36' W. a distance of 6861 feet Describe as being within a 40-acre subdivision of public survey, and by course and distance to a section corner. If on unsurveyed land, to the SW. corner of Sec. 31 T.21N., R. 51 E. M.D.B. & M. (unsurveyed land) it should be stated.

6. Place of use NE 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 7 T.20N., R. 51 E. M.D.B. & M. (Unsurveyed land) Describe by legal subdivision, if on unsurveyed land it should be so stated.

7. Use will begin about January 1 and end about December 31, of each year. Month and Day

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to all existing rights on the source. It is understood that the amount of water herein granted is only a temporary allowance and that the final water right obtained under this permit will be dependent upon the period of use and the average number of livestock served from the waters of this source. It is further understood that this right must allow for a reasonable lowering of the static water level at permittee's well due to any other ground water development in the area. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening for measuring depth to water. If well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times but does not take responsibility for the use of the Federal range.

This Permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

This permit is issued under the provisions of NRS 534.120(2) as a preferred use.

This permit is issued with the express understanding and on the condition that existing grazing use of the public range by authorized users or permittees will not be impaired or adversely affected by approval and issuance of this permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.0071 cubic feet per second, or sufficient water to water 200 head of cattle and 30 horses.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before N/A

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before N/A

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before January 5, 1985

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before February 5, 1985

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before January 5, 1987

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before February 5, 1987
