APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the place of use of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 19116, Certificate 6426, is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 19116, Certificate 6426, and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit is issued subject to the provisions of the State Engineer's Orders Nos. 809 and 813.

If either of Permits 43268 or 43836 are withdrawn or cancelled, the waters under these permits will not revert to the former place of use (9.04 acres within SW¼ SE¼ Section 7, 0.955 acres within SE¼ SW¼ Section 7, both in T. 22 N., R. 54 E., M.D.B.&M., 9.205 acres within the NW¼ SE¼ Section 18, T. 22 N., R. 54 E., M.D.B.&M.) under the base rights, but will revert to the source. (PERMIT TERMS CONTINUED)

The amount of water to be changed shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed..... 1.21 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed a yearly duty of 4.0 acre-feet per acre of land irrigated from any and/or all sources, and not to exceed 782.10 acre-feet annually.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before..... April 1, 1984

(PERMIT TERMS CONTINUED)

If Permits 43268, 43836 and 43269 are withdrawn or cancelled, then the waters will revert to the base rights (Permits 19116 and 32890) and will not revert to the source. However, if Permits 43268, 43836 and 43269 are all withdrawn or cancelled, then the lands under irrigation within the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 18, T. 21 N., R. 53 E., M.D.B.&M., will be reduced by 19.2 acres.

The issuance of this permit totally abrogates Permit 19116, Certificate 6426.
