The applicant Amax Inc.

Colorado 80401, hereby make s application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation; if a copartnership or association, give names of members.) Incorporated in New York, 1887

- 1. The source of the proposed appropriation is underground
2. The amount of water applied for is 4.0 second-feet
3. The water to be used for milling, mining and domestic
4. If use is for: (a) Irrigation (state number of acres to be irrigated)
5. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point: Within the SE 1/4 of the SE 1/4 of Section 25, T. 32N., R. 43E., M.D.B.&M.
6. Place of use. Within portion of Section 30 and 31, T. 32N., R. 44E.; Section 25 and 36, T. 32N., R. 43E., and Section 2, 16, 18, 20, 28, 30 and 32, T. 31N., R. 44E., M.D.B. & M.
7. Use will begin about January 1 and end about December 31, of each year.
8. Description of proposed works. (Under the provisions of NRS 535.010 you may be required to submit plans and specifications of your diversion or storage works.) Drilled and cased well, pump, electric motor, distribution system and storage reservoir.

- 9. Estimated cost of works. \$50,000
- 10. Estimated time required to construct works. seven years
If well completed, describe works.
- 11. Estimated time required to complete the application to beneficial use. ten years

12. Remarks: For use other than irrigation or stock watering, state number and type of units to be served or annual consumptive use.

The water developed pursuant to this application will be commingled with water developed from other permits owned by the permittee. The total combined duty from all sources will not exceed 25,000 acre feet per year. The mill will operate 24 hours per day, 365 days per year. Recycling and conservation of water will be maximized.


