APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to all existing rights on the source and with the understanding that all of the water herein granted will be returned to the stream at the point designated in the application, free from deleterious matter, and with the further understanding that the proof of beneficial use, when filed, will show the power generated and the amount of water required and used therefor. A suitable measuring device must be installed and accurate measurements of water placed to beneficial use be kept. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This Permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal, and local agencies.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 2.2 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 519.29 million gallons annually.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before February 13, 1987
