1. The source of water is New Spring.  
Name of stream, lake, underground spring or other source.

2. The amount of water to be changed 0.1 c.f.s.  
Second feet, acre feet. One second foot equals 448.83 gallons per minute.

3. The water to be used for Industrial and Domestic  
Irrigation, power, mining, industrial, etc. If for stock state number and kind of animals.

4. The water heretofore permitted for Milling, Metallurgical and Domestic  
Irrigation, power, mining, industrial, etc. If for stock state number and kind of animals.

5. The water is to be diverted at the following point within the SW 1/4 of Section 23, T.15N., R.62E., M.D.B.&M; or at a point from which the SW Corner of said Section 23 bears distance to a section corner. If on unsurveyed land, it should be stated.  
S. 42°31'49" W., at a distance of 4,642.15 feet.

6. The existing permitted point of diversion is located within at a spring near the SE 1/4 Corner of the NE 1/4 of Section 23, T.15N., R.62E., M.D.B. & M. Note: This is an erroneous description of where the New Spring is located.  
If point of diversion is not changed, do not answer.

7. Proposed place of use All of Sections 12 and 13, T.16N., R.61E., Sections 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17, 18, 19, 20, 21, and 22, T.16N., R.62E., and ALSO Sections 7, 17, 18, 19 and 20, T.16N., R.63E., M.D.B. & M.  
Describe by legal subdivisions. If for irrigation state number of acres to be irrigated.

8. Existing place of use Copper Flat, White Pine County, Nevada  
Describe by legal subdivisions. If permit is for irrigation, state number of acres irrigated. If changing place of use and/or manner of use of irrigation permit, describe acreage to be removed from irrigation.

9. Use will be from January 1 to December 31 of each year.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion, manner of use and place of use of the waters of New Spring as heretofore granted under Permit 2087, Certificate 17, is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 2087, Certificate 17, and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. A measuring device must be installed and measurements of water use kept.

This Permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

This permit is subject to the condition that the permittee must ensure that wildlife which have customarily used such water will have access thereto, NRS 533.367.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal, and local agencies.

The amount of water to be changed shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.10 cubic feet per second.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before April 18, 1985

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before May 18, 1985

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before April 18, 1988

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before May 18, 1988
