hereby make application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation; if a copartnership or association, give names of members.) April 30, 1946, Delaware

5. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point: NE 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 3, T31N, R53E, MDB & M., at a point from which the SW corner of Section 34, T32N, R53E, MDB & M., bears N 55° 07' 49" W 5579.56 feet.
Describe as being within a 40-acre subdivision of public survey, and by course and distance to a section corner. If on unsurveyed land, it should be stated.

6. Place of use E 1/2 Section 8, All of Sections 1, 3, 10, 12 & 14, T31N, R53E, MDB & M.; All of Sections 34 & 35, T32N, R53E, MDB & M; All of Section 31, T32N, R54E, MDB & M; All of Sections 5, 6 & 18, T31N, R54E, MDB & M.
Describe by legal subdivision, if on unsurveyed land it should be so stated.

7. Use will begin about January 1 and end about December 31, of each year.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to existing rights. It is understood that the amount of water herein granted is only a temporary allowance and that the final water right obtained under this permit will be dependent upon the amount of water actually placed to beneficial use. It is also understood that this right must allow for a reasonable lowering of the static water level. This well shall be equipped with a two (2) inch opening for measuring depth to water. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. A totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of water begins, or before the Proof of Completion of Work is filed. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer, pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

The total combined duty of water under Permits 43925, 44052, 44056, 46346, 46347 and 47341 shall not exceed 587.8 million gallons annually.

The total combined diversion rate of Permits 43925, 44052, 44056, 46346, 46347 and 47341 shall not exceed 6.0 c.f.s.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal, and local agencies.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 6.0 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 587.8 million gallons annually.
