hereby makes application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation; if a copartnership or association, give names of members.) March 10, 1980; Nevada

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is underground

2. The amount of water applied for is 0.5 second-foot

(a) If stored in reservoir give number of acre-feet

3. The water to be used for mining, milling, and domestic

5. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point: in the SE1/4 SW1/4 Section 28,

T. 15N., R. 34E., (unsurveyed land), M.D.B. & M. or at a point from which the SW corner of Section 34, T. 16N., R. 34E., M.D.B. & M. bears N. 6°42'21" E., 25,776.4 feet.

6. Place of use Sections 34 and 36, T. 17N., R. 34E., and Sections 1, 2, 11, 12, 13, 14,

23, 24, 25, 26, 27, 34, and 35, T. 16N., R. 34E., and Sections 2, 3, 10, 11, 14,

15, 16, 21, 22, 23, 26, 27, and 28, T. 15N., R. 34E., (unsurveyed), M.D.B. & M.

7. Use will begin about January 1 and end about December 31, of each year.

8. Description of proposed works. (Under the provisions of NRS 535.010 you may be required to submit plans and specifications of your diversion or storage works.) well, casing, pump, storage tank, and pipeline to plant site.

State manner in which water is to be diverted, i.e. diversion structure, ditches and flumes, drilled well with pump and motor, etc.

9. Estimated cost of works \$50,000.00

10. Estimated time required to construct works 2 years
