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The applicant **ZIMMERMAN RANCHING CORP.**, hereby makes application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated. **Nevada 1972**

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1. The source of the proposed appropriation is **underground**
2. The amount of water applied for is **6.0 c.f.s.** second-feet
  - (a) If stored in reservoir give number of acre-feet
3. The water to be used for **irrigation**
4. If use is for:
  - (a) Irrigation, state number of acres to be irrigated **1,120 acres**
  - (b) Stockwater, state number and kinds of animals to be watered
  - (c) Other use (describe fully under No. 12. "Remarks")
  - (d) Power:
    - (1) Horsepower developed
    - (2) Point of return of water to stream
5. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point **within the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 4, T.12N., R.43E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the South  $\frac{1}{4}$  corner of said Section 4 bears S37°51'W 2,016.0'.**
6. Place of Use **SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 33, SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 34 of T.13N., R.43E., M.D.B.&M., and the W $\frac{1}{2}$  of Section 3, E $\frac{1}{2}$  of Section 4, N $\frac{1}{2}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 9, and the N $\frac{1}{2}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 10 of T.12N., R.43E., M.D.B.&M.**
7. Use will begin about **January 1st** and end about **December 31st** of each year.
8. Description of proposed works **Well, pump, motor, pipelines and ditches.**
9. Estimated cost of works **\$20,000.00**
10. Estimated time required to construct works **Complete 16" well 500' deep**
11. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use **five (5) years**

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APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to existing rights. It is understood that the amount of water herein granted is only a temporary allowance and that the final water right obtained under this permit will be dependent upon the amount of water actually placed to beneficial use. It is also understood that this right must allow for a reasonable lowering of the static water level. This well shall be equipped with a two (2) inch opening for measuring depth to water. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. A substantial weir or other type of measuring device must be installed and measurements of water use kept. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer, pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The total combined duty of water under Permit 14014, Certificate 4498; Permit 14015, Certificate 4499; Permit 30130, Certificate 12978; Permits 32420, 44373, 44374, 45528, 45529, 45530, 56192, 56678 and 59759 shall not exceed 20,480 acre-feet annually for the irrigation of 5,120 acres of which 3,648.2 acres is supplemental to the decreed waters of North Twin River and South Twin River and tributaries under Claim 02408 and the decreed waters of Last Chance, Ophir, Wisconsin and Summit Creeks under Claim 0722.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The total combined diversion rate under Permits 30130, Certificate 12978; and 44373 shall not exceed 5.4 cubic feet per second.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 5.4 cubic feet per second, **but not to exceed 486.0 acre-feet annually and not to exceed a yearly duty of 4.0 acre-feet per acre of land irrigated from any and/or all sources.**

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before:

January 28, 2005

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before:

February 28, 2005

Water must be placed to beneficial use on or before:

January 28, 2007

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:

February 28, 2007

Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before:

February 28, 2007
