

APPLICATION FOR PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS OF THE STATE OF NEVADA

The applicant The Nature Conservancy 156 Second Street, of San Francisco, CA 94105, hereby make application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated.

(If applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation; if a copartnership or association, give names of members.)

Applicant is a non-profit corporation incorporated under the laws of the District of Columbia on 10/22/51

- 1. The source of the proposed appropriation is that portion of Meadow Valley Wash, a perennial stream in Lincoln County, Nevada which flows through Conder Canyon near Panaca.
2. The amount of water applied for is the total highwater flow or 3.0 second-feet.
3. The water to be used for the propagation of fishspecies- a non-consumptive use.
4. If use is for: (a) Irrigation (state number of acres to be irrigated), (b) Stockwater (state number and kinds of animals to be watercd), (c) Other use (describe fully under "No. 12. Remarks") see exhibit A filed with original application, (d) Power: (1) Horsepower developed, (2) Point of return of water to stream.

5. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point: located within the NW 1/4 of the SE 1/4 of Section 13, T1S, R68E, M.D.B. & M. Lincoln County, Nevada; or at a point from which the Southeast Corner or said Section 13 bears S42°E a distance of 3098 feet.

6. Place of use The natural stream channel of Meadow Valley Wash as it passes through Conder Canyon beginning within the NW 1/4-SE 1/4, Sec. 13 & as follows: NE 1/4-SW 1/4, SE 1/4-SW 1/4, SW 1/4-SW 1/4, Sec. 13; the NW 1/4-NW 1/4, SW 1/4-NW 1/4 Sec. 24; the SE 1/4-NE 1/4, NE 1/4-SE 1/4, NW 1/4-SE 1/4, SW 1/4-SE 1/4, SE 1/4-SW 1/4, SW 1/4-SW 1/4 Sec. 23; the NW 1/4-NW 1/4 Sec. 26; the NE 1/4-NE 1/4, SE 1/4-NE 1/4, SW 1/4-NE 1/4, NW 1/4-SE 1/4, NE 1/4-SW 1/4, NW 1/4-SW 1/4 Sec. 27, and the NE 1/4-SE 1/4 Sec. 28, all within T1S, R68E, M.D.B. & M. Lincoln County Nevada

7. Use will begin about Jan. 1-st and end about Dec. 31-st, of each year.

8. Description of proposed works. (Under the provisions of NRS 535.010 you may be required to submit plans and specifications of your diversion or storage works.) No water works will be established. The intent of the application is to maintain the existing stream flow in its natural state.

This permit is issued for a non-consumptive use and is subject to the permitted rights and to the determination of the relative rights to the waters of Meadow Valley Wash and Tributaries that may be made under adjudication proceedings under NRS 533.090 through 533.320. Any application to change the manner or place of use granted under this permit will be subject to additional determination and evaluation with respect to the effects on existing rights and the resource.

This Permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 3.0 cubic feet per second.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before N/A

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before N/A

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before May 24, 1984

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before June 24, 1984
