APPLICATION FOR PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS OF THE STATE OF NEVADA

Nevada 89425, hereby make application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation; if a copartnership or association, give names of members.) March 9, 1966, in Kansas

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is West Side Spring AKA Tub Spring
Name of stream, lake or other source.

2. The amount of water applied for is .0156 CFS second-feet
One second-foot equals 448.83 gals. per min.

3. The water to be used for Stockwater
Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic, or other use. Must limit to one use.

The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point: NW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 36, T. 39 N., R. 35 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the Northeast corner of Section 20, T. 39 N., R. 36 E., M.D.B. & M., bears N 45° 44' W, a distance of 21,404 feet. Describe as being within a 40-acre subdivision of public survey, and by course and distance to a section corner. If on unsurveyed land, it should be stated.

6. Place of use NW 1/4 SW 1/4, Section 36, T. 39 N., R. 35 E., M.D.B. & M., Humboldt County, Nevada
Describe by legal subdivision, if on unsurveyed land it should be so stated.

7. Use will begin about January 1 and end about December 31, of each year.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to all existing rights on the source. It is understood that the amount of water herein granted is only a temporary allowance and that the final water right obtained under this permit will be dependent upon the period of use and the average number of livestock served from the waters of this source. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times but does not take responsibility for the use of the Federal range.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

This permit is subject to the condition that the permittee must ensure that wildlife which have customarily used such water will have access thereto, NRS 533.367.

This permit is issued subject to the State Engineer's ruling No. 3747 dated October 11, 1990.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.0156 cubic feet per second, or sufficient to water 500 head of cattle.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before N/A

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before N/A

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 24, 1991

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before November 24, 1991

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before October 24, 1993

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before November 24, 1993

Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before N/A
